- **Full Papers:** Papers allocated 30 minutes for oral presentation (including discussion). These papers are assigned a 10-page limit in the conference proceedings.
- **Short Papers:** Papers allocated 20 minutes for oral presentation (including discussion). These papers are assigned a 6-page limit in the conference proceedings.
- **Posters:** Papers presented as poster are assigned a 4-page limit in the conference proceedings.

Prospective authors are invited to submit papers in any of the topics listed above. Instructions for preparing the manuscript (in Word and Latex formats) are available at: Paper Templates. Please also check the Submission Guidelines. Papers should be submitted electronically via the web-based submission system at: <http://www.insticc.org/Primoris>

Acceptance notifications will be sent out on February 17, 2014. The workshop will be held on April 27-30, 2014 in Lisbon, Portugal. Please note that at least one author of an accepted position paper must register for the workshop and for one or more days of the ICEIS 2014 conference. Papers should be formatted according to ICEIS 2014 Archive Format (<http://www.iceis.org/GuidelinesTemplates.aspx>).

PUBLICATION

All accepted papers will be published in the conference proceedings, under an ISBN reference, on paper and on CD-ROM support. SCITEPRESS is member of CrossRef (<http://www.crossref.org/>).
